## NOTICE TO RESIDENTS IN THE VILLAGE OF CLINTON AND SURROUNDING AREA.

The Village is posting this notice to inform residents of the latest Wildfire Information currently affecting the Village of Clinton and surrounding area.

**PUBLIC MEETING AT THE HALL TONIGHT AT 5:00 PM**

### **CACHE CREEK/ASHCROFT FIRE:**

- ASHCROFT RESERVE FIRE –As of the 11:00 am Information Update the fire is reported to be the largest in the area at just over 52,000 hectares.
- **THE VILLAGE OF CLINTON CONTINUES TO BE ON EVACUATION ALERT**
- **EVACUATION ORDERS AND ALERTS ARE EVALUATED ON A DAILY BASIS AND ARE UPDATED DAILY ON THE TNRD AND EMERGENCY INFO WEBSITES.**

### **Three Stages of Evacuation:**

**Evacuation Alert:** Be ready to leave on short notice. If you leave before or during this alert, it's called a voluntary evacuation.

**Evacuation Order:** You are at risk. Leave the area immediately. Local police or RCMP enforce evacuation orders.

**Evacuation Rescind:** All is currently safe and you can return home. Stay tuned for other possible evacuation alerts or orders.

### **HIGHWAY CLOSURES:**

- Traffic control remains in place for Hwy 97
- Highway 24 is open and traffic control has been removed at this time with minimal traffic patterns.

### **MEDICAL CONCERNS:**

If you require any medications or have medical concerns contact the Village Health Centre at 250-459-2080 and they will do their best to assist you with your needs.
